To be a part of this event, you must meet the eligibility requirements of Skydive Jersey Shore\* (the premier skydiving center of New Jersey). You must pay a \$25 non refundable registration fee and raise a minimum of \$500. The \$500 will cover your training, your tandem jump (tandem=jumping with an instructor), a T-shirt and donation to CCFA (Deadline for registration and \$25 fee is March 1, 2004. Pledges are due no later than March 21, 2004).
